



## Trimley St Martin – Equalities Objectives

### Equality objective 1:

- a) **KS2** to raise the % **expected** attainment in **reading and RWM** for girls to bring in line with boys  
b) **KS1** to raise the % **expected** attainment in **writing and RWM** for boys to bring in line with girls

#### Why we have chosen this objective:

The percentage of girls reaching expected attainment is lower than that of boys

Key Stage	Girls - % reaching exceeded attainment	Boys - % reaching exceeded attainment
KS1	53% (19% decrease from 2018)	31% (11% decrease from 2018)
Writing RWM	53% (14% decrease from 2018)	31% (11% decrease from 2018)
KS2	Girls - % reaching expected attainment	Boys - % reaching expected attainment
Reading RWM	82% (% same as 2018) 53% (% same as 2018)	54% (25% decrease from 2018) 46% (18% decrease from 2018)

#### To achieve this objective we plan to:

- KS1 – Identify pupils with potential to attain Expected in Y1 and Y2 – using school assessment tracking
- Identify the objectives required from the Interim Framework to achieve Expected
  - Provide Quality First Teaching, to include differentiation within lessons to accommodate the needs of these pupils
  - Establish an intervention group to support the children in reaching the targets set
- KS2 – Track girls and boys reaching expected as a comparison
- Identify overdue targets and put in place intervention groups to close the gaps
  - Ensure well-pitched activities to challenge and extend understanding/comprehension and use of vocabulary

#### We are making towards achieving this objective:

- New Tracking system in place, to track progress and for gap analysis
- Non-negotiable statements in the interim framework for all year groups have been established
- SLT working with identified groups in Year 6 and newly introduced to Y2
- Gaps have been identified for children and intervention groups are in place to close the gaps
- Y2 & Y6 teachers attended moderation training for writing
