<u>Equality objective 2:</u> to reduce the gap for expected attainment (KS1) and progress (KS2- M) for SEN children in **reading**, writing and maths in line with the attainment of the cohort

we have chosen this objective:

The attainment and progress of SEN of children falls below that of the Non SEN group

To achieve this objective we plan to:

- KS2 Identify and track SEN/Non SEN in next cohorts
 - Identify overdue targets and put in place intervention groups to close the gaps in progress
 - Ensure well-pitched activities to challenge and extend mathematical thinking using White Rose
 - Ensure opportunities for extended writing

Progress we are making towards achieving this objective:

- White Rose planning has been introduced in KS 1 and 2 and CPD delivered to all staff
- Whole school training on Multiplication
- Non-negotiable statements in the interim framework for all year groups
- Time given to staff to analyse the context of groups in classes
- Gaps have been identified for children and intervention groups are in place to close the gaps
- Moderation meetings held within school and within cluster
- Progress meetings held termly to track progress and attainment
- SLT working with identified groups for maths intervention and writing
