With a few weeks to go... we just thought we'd send out information about key arrangements for the day:

- Children need to come to school wearing their P.E. kit, both KS 1 & KS 2.
- Children will wear their P.E. kits for the duration of the day. They will need to wear a coloured **t-shirt (preferably not a football shirt)** to match the house team they are representing. If you do not have that colour t-shirt at home, please do not go out and buy! Children can wear their plain P.E. t-shirt and we'll stick a coloured sticker on the t-shirt.
- KS1 events start at 9:15am (expected to finish around 11:30am.)
- KS2 event start at 1:15pm
- Parents / carers / family & friends are more than welcome to spectate – for some events there will be clearly marked areas for spectators.
- PICNIC lunch starts at 11:45 ish. Parents are invited to bring lunch and eat with their children (weather permitting). ALL CHILDREN will need a packed lunch, brought into school in the morning as usual. A packed lunch will be provided for children who receive free school dinners (unless declined).
- The only gate that will be open in order for spectators to gain access to the school will be the car park gate.

# Forgotten Sports Kit
