<p>RESEARCH WRITING <i>Find out about more about a famous Graffiti artist (Banksy or Keith Haring are good examples) and write a detailed report about them.</i> Look at the PowerPoints on Mandela Blog for more information.</p>	<p>BIOGRAPHY WRITING <i>Write a biography fact file of a famous Graffiti artist (Banksy or Keith Haring are good examples).</i> Look at the PowerPoints on Mandela Blog for more information.</p>	<p>MUSIC/LYRIC WRITING Graffiti is often linked to rap music. <i>Write and perform your own rap.</i> Create a video presentation for your performance or type it up and add audio using the Seesaw microphone function.</p>	<p>PE/DT Graffiti is often linked to skate boarding. <i>Create your own scooter or skate obstacle/stunt course for you or your family to complete.</i> Take a video or photo of your finished course.</p>
<p>DEBATE WRITING <i>Write a two sided debate, for and against, considering:</i> <i>Is Graffiti Art or Vandalism?</i> Include a paragraph of reasons for and a paragraph of reasons against. After considering both sides write a conclusion, deciding which side you support.</p>	<p>HISTORY <i>Find out about the history of Graffiti and how it originated.</i> Find a fun way to present your findings. This could be through models, a video, information book, comic... whatever you would like.</p>	<p>GEOGRAPHY Graffiti originated on the streets of Philadelphia in the USA. <i>Find out more about the American city.</i> Include facts, maps and pictures.</p>	<p>PE Graffiti is often linked to Street Dance. Find out more about Street Dance: https://youtu.be/ujREEgxEP7g <i>Create your own dance - record some of your moves!</i></p>
