MUSIC/ART

Listen to the piece of music by **Holst** called 'Planets'. As you are listening to the music use paint to make markings on the paper. If the music is quick and light, think which type of marks you could make with your paints.

Design and make a moon buggy. Include annotated sketches of your design before making it.

ART

View from your space window – use whatever art materials you would like to draw an image to show what you might see if you looked out of your rocket window into space.

HISTORY

Find out about the first moon landing. Present your information any way you choose – it could be a newspaper, fact file, diary... whatever you would like.

POETRY WRITING

Write a poem about space. This could be an acrostic poem, shape poem, free verse poem or a simple rhyming couplet based poem.

STORY WRITING

Write a story linked to space. Remember to use DADWAVERS to help you.

SCIENCE INVESTIGATION

Space is dark. Dark is the absence of light! See if you can investigate the best material for keeping light out. Design what would be the best material to make blackout glasses. Why? Prove it! Remember to support your answer with research, evidence, diagrams and pictures.

Find out more about the Solar System. Find a fun way to present your findings. This could be through models, a video, information book, comic... whatever you would like.
