Muscular Dystrophy UK is the charity for the 70,000 people living with muscle-wasting conditions in the UK. They work together with people affected by more than 60 rare and very rare progressive muscle-weakening and wasting conditions. Since 1959, the charity has been supporting individuals and families living with muscle-wasting conditions by providing vital information, advice and resources.

The day will be filled with orange themed learning and finishing with a mini Go Orange fete and sponsored event. Each class will have their own event or stall. Anything from orange cakes and popcorn to an orange sponge throw. (Who will we put in the stocks? Could it be Mr Case our Parent Governor or will he be doing something else?).
